NEIGHBORHOOD NEWS

A NEW MURAL IN ROSCOE VILLAGE

You might have noticed a recent addition to Roscoe Village - the new mural at the corner of Damen and School Street. Completed last November by Detroit based artist, Louise "Ouizi" Jones, the mural was commissioned by property owners Daran Redenbaugh and Janette Scott.

Built in 1911 as a local butcher and grocery, the building has had many uses over the years, including as a photographer's studio and a dance studio. Scott, an architect, designed the multi-phase conversion of the building to the couple's home where they have lived since they purchased the property in 2019. As part of the renovation, the couple intended to sandblast and restore the brick wall along School Street, which was painted white after numerous tagging over the years. However, unable to afford the masonry repair costs, the couple wondered if a mural might be a better solution. The couple discovered Louise Jones who completed the "Urbs in Horto" mural along the Southport Corridor on Instagram and fell in love with her work. Encouraged by friends and neighbors, Redenbaugh set up a GoFundMe page to raise money for the mural. With a goal of bringing joy to the neighborhood and celebrating the flora and fauna of the Midwest, even in the depths of winter, the mural depicts



a bouquet of flowers including peonies, rudbeckia, echinacea, tulips, coreopsis, flowering dogwood, and a swallowtail butterfly. Overall, friends, neighbors and the people of Roscoe Village contributed almost \$6,000 to fund the mural, with the couple making up the balance of the costs. The mural is listed in the City of Chicago's online Mural Registry and is already a hit with neighbors, Instagrammers and passersby.

A note from your RVN Committee:

NEIGHBORS ON WATCH (NoW)

With Spring approaching most Chicagoans are looking forward to shedding the Winter clothing and spending more time outside. As we all do this it's important to be vigilant and aware of your surroundings and take precautions.

- Don't leave your car running unattended or unlocked.
- Don't leave any items of interest in your car. Backpacks, earbuds, phone cables, etc. are all inviting to criminals.
 If you have a garage but park on the street, don't leave your garage opener in plain sight.
- Keep all doors and windows locked at home. If you have an alarm, use it.
- Turn on outside lights at night and have indoor lights on a timer when not at home.
- Don't let mail/packages pile up outside your home or apartment. Also things like dead flowers in front of your home indicate that you might be away.
- Lock bikes up with a secure cable or lock. Look for a CPD free registration event where you can have your bike etched with a code to mitigate theft.
- Be aware of door-to-door scams. Groups of people will attempt to enter you home claiming to be from a public utility or cable/phone company.
- If you see suspicious behavior call 911.

The Chicago Police Department holds Beat Meetings every 2 months to talk about crime in our area, what's being done and hear residents' concerns. Roscoe Village area beat meetings are held at CPD's station at Western and Belmont. This QR Code shows the Beat Meeting schedule and maps to identify which Beat area you fall into.
